

Lead Paint Statement Notification

The United States government enacted a new law that requires apartment renters to be given information necessary to prevent lead poisoning in apartments. Approximately three-quarters of the nation's housing built before 1978 contain some lead-based paint. When properly maintained and managed, this paint poses little risk. Apartment renters are receiving this information, prior to rental, on known lead-based paint hazards, in University Apartments.

It is our duty to inform you of this law and to give you this information to use to keep your family safe in this housing and any other housing you may sometime buy or rent. Please feel free to ask any questions you might have and to call our Maintenance staff at 217-333-2779 to report any paint repairs needed.

Lead Warning Statement

Housing built before 1978 may contain lead-based paint. Lead from paint, paint chips and dust can pose health hazards if not taken care of properly. Lead exposure is especially harmful to young children and pregnant women. Before renting pre-1978 housing, landlords must disclose the presence of known lead-based paint and lead-based paint hazards in the dwelling. Resident must also receive a federally approved pamphlet on lead poisoning prevention. A pdf of this brochure is available online.
